

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, May 22, 1913

The Board met in adjourned session with all members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

This being the day set for final action on the County Road System, the Board took this matter up for consideration

The petition of Hans Boysen et al for a change in the proposed County Road System in Lincoln Township was received and placed on file. The Board listened to oral argument by Mr. Boysen, who argued for the proposed change.

The Board of Trustees of Fairview Township were present and made oral request for additional County Road in Fairview Township and marked a map which showed the addition asked for.

Oral Objections by Jos. H. Paup and others to the petition of Hans Boysen et al were heard.

The petition of D. J. Carmichael and forty other land owners and residents of Center and Monroe Townships was received and placed on file, said petition asked for additional County Road from the Northeast corner of Section 10, Monroe Township, running thence both west and north to Harlan.

The next petition to be filed and received was that of C. J. Harris et al, requesting that additional County Road in Center and Polk Townships be provided for, which road should lead into Harlan. Said petition was accompanied by plat showing the route of the road petitioned for.

Board on motion adjourned to 1:30 P. M.

Board met at 1:30 P. M. as per adjournment.

The Board again took up the consideration of the County Road System and the following action was taken.

The petition of Hans Boysen et al for a change of the County Road in Lincoln Township was referred to the State Highway Commission.

The petition of the Trustees of Fairview Township was granted and the County Road System was ordered extended south from Corley on the east side of the river to connect with the County Road in Pottawattamie County.

The Board then took up for consideration the petition of D.J. Carmichael et al for a County Road from the Northeast corner of Section 10 in Monroe Township in a westerly and northerly direction to Harlan and this petition was granted as prayed for.

The petition of C. J. Harris et al for additional highway in Center and Polk Townships was referred to the State Highway Commission.

The Board on motion adjourned sine die.
