

## Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

January

Session, 1912

Harlan, Iowa, January 8, 1913

The Board of Supervisors met today in adjourned session with all members present. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

On motion the Clerk of the District Court was allowed \$300.00 from the Probate Fees of his office in addition to his salary for the years 1913 and 1914.

The Board on motion granted the application of William Hayes for a School Fund Loan of \$800.00 as soon as money is available.

The Board then approved the Justice of the Peace Annual Reports of E. B. Tucker and James D. Dunlavy.

The Board then approved the following Officials bonds:--

The County Treasurer, Geo. H. Miller, presented the following Bank Depositors Bonds which were examined and approved.

At the time of adjournment the Board, not having completed their settlement with the Treasurer, adjourned to 8:30 A. M., January 9, 1913, to resume the settlement.

Board met as per adjournment and completed settlement with the Treasurer and it was ascertained that Geo. H. Miller, County Treasurer, had in his possession the sum of \$77,566.76, which was produced by him in cash and certificates of deposit to the satisfaction of the Board. The Board then examined and approved the Annual Bridge Reports made for the East, West and South districts. (See reports on file in this office.)

The Board then examined and approved the following Township Trustees Annual Reports: Shelby, Douglas, Polk, Jefferson. (See Reports on file in this office)

The Board then proceeded to audit and allow claims. (See Claim Register No. 7.)

The Board then adjourned to 1:30 P. M.

The Board met as per adjournment.

The County Auditor was directed to transfer from the Douglas Township road fund the amount due Drainage District No. 1, Shelby County, Iowa.

The Board on motion adjourned subject to call of County Auditor.
