Special January

Session, 1913

Harlan, Iowa, January 29, 1913

The Board met in called session today with all members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The following Trustees' Annual Reports were examined, approved and ordered placed on file:--Grove, Fairview, Lincoln.

The Greeley Township report was ordered returned for correction.

The County Recorder appeared before the Board stating that the old typewriter in his office was pretty well worn, and the Board, after considering the matter purchased a new L. C. Smith Typewriter, trading the Monarch Typewriter now in use in and paying the difference of \$55.00 in cash.

The Board then adjourned to 1:30 o'clock P. M.

The Board met at 1:30 o'clock P. M. as per adjournment.

The bids for the printing of the 1912 Financial Report were opened and found to be as follows:-

The Annual Report of M. H. Woods, Justice of the Peace, was examined and approved.

The Board then granted the application of P. H. Jorgensen for an extension of a School Fund Loan in the sum of \$135.00.

The Board then began the auditing and allowing of claims.
