Session, 1913

Harlan, Iowa, April 7, 1913

The Board of Supervisors met this day in regular session with the following members present, Arthur Pryor, acting Chairman, Geo. E. Miller and E. A. Schell, County Auditor. Mr. C. P. Jacobsen, Chairman of the Board, was unable to be present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board then approved the bond of Carl S. Christiansen as Justice of the Peace in the sum of \$500.00; and also approved the bond of Wm. Kolb as Township Clerk in Clay Township, in the sum of \$2000.00.

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The Board then approved the Drainage Petition of Geo. S. Kees et al and ordered same placed on file.

The Board on motion adjourned to 8:30 A. M. April 8, 1913.

On motion the bond of the Harlan National Bank as a Depository Bank in the sum \$50,000.00 was approved.

The Board then met with a committee of the Shelby County Automobile Association and discussed plans for the expending of the County Motor Vehicle Road Fund in the various townships of the County. It was agreed that \$150.00 be apportioned to each township, same to be expended under the direction of the Township Road Superintendent and to be used on the main traveled roads. The Auditor was instructed to notify all the township Clerks in the county of this agreement.

On motion the Board adjourned subject to call of the County Auditor.
