

## Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, May 6, 1913.

The Board of Supervisors met in called session today with all members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board then marked and designated the County Road System as provided by law and May 22, 1913 at 10 A. M. was fixed as a date for hearing objections to the proposed establishment of said County Road System.

The Board then adjourned to 2 o'clock P. M.

The Board met at 2 o'clock P. M. as per adjournment.

The petition of Fred Martinson et al for the establishment of a Drainage District, commencing in Section 6, Center Township, and running thence South to the South line of Section 32 in Fairview Township, Shelby County, Iowa, and terminating at said point, was received and placed on file. Said petition being accompanied by a bond in the sum of \$1200.00, which bond was approved. J. H. Mayne was selected as Engineer to make the preliminary survey. His compensation was fixed at \$50.00 per mile for making the survey. The County Auditor was directed to draw up a contract with Mr. Mayne and his bond was fixed at \$1000.00. Both contract and bond to be filed before preliminary survey is begun.

The Board granted the refund of W. J. Davis of \$12.04 on land sold to city for a dump ground, this being the first installment of 1912 taxes, and the second installment was ordered cancelled.

The Board refused to grant the refund to B. B. Bowen of 1912 tax on moneys and credits.

The Board granted the recommendation of the city council of Harlan, and cancelled the taxes of Mrs. J. E. Inlow on Lot 3 in Block 91, McDonalds Add. to the Town of Harlan, for the year 1912.

County Supervisor C. P. Jacobson filed his resignation as a member of the Board and same was on motion accepted. Upon call of the County Auditor, G. K. Swift, Clerk of the District Court, Henry F. Wunder, County Recorder, and E. A. Schell, County Auditor met in the office of the County Supervisors and elected Hans Brodersen county supervisors to succeed C. P. Jacobson, resigned. Board on motion adjourned to 8:30 A. M. Wednesday, May 7, 1913.

The Board met at 8:30 A. M. May 7, 1913, as per adjournment. Hans Brodersen, the newly elected member of the Board took the oath of office administered by E. A. Schell, County Auditor.

The Board organized by electing Arthur Pryor as Chairman for the remainder of the year 1913.

The Board then proceeded to appoint a County Engineer. C. E. Wright of Ames, Iowa, was elected for this position and his salary fixed at \$100.00 per month, with the understanding that he furnish bond in the sum of \$1000.00.

The Board on motion adjourned to 1:30 P. M.

The Board met as per adjournment with all members present.

The Board then completed the contract with C. E. Wright as County Engineer,

The Board began the auditing of of Claims and completed same.
