

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, Nov. 10, 1913.

The Board of Supervisors met today in regular session with the following members present, Chairman Arthur Fryer, Members Geo E Miller, Hans Brodersen, and County Auditor E A Schell.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board then took up for consideration the Resolution of Necessity for the construction of certain bridges, this resolution was passed on October 27th, 1913, and the following final resolution was passed.

Whereas on the 27th day of October, 1913, the Board passed a certain Resolution of Necessity, and fixed November 10th, 1913, for a hearing on said Resolution, same being in conformity with the public notice thereof as required by law.

Be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa that it now fully determines to construct the bridges and culverts described in said Resolution of Necessity.

Upon the recommendation of the City Council of Harlan, Iowa, the Board canceled the taxes of Oliver McDowell for the year 1913, on lots 7 & 8 in Block 4 Long's 2nd Add. to Harlan, Iowa, and they also canceled all personal taxes against said Oliver McDowell for the year 1913.

The Board granted a refund of \$14.54 to C E Grosiar, on account of erroneous assessment. This was done in compliance with a recommendation of the City Council of Harlan.

The consent road petition of Arthur Driggins & C J Wheelen for additional land for public highway in section 8, Twp 81, Range 40, was granted.

The Board on Motion adjourned to 1.30 P.M.

Met at 1.30 P.M. as per adjournment.

The Board then began auditing claims, and devoted the afternoon to this work.

On Motion adjourned to 8.30 A.M., Nov. 11.

Met at 8.30 A.M. as per adjournment.

Continued auditing claims during the forenoon.

Adjourned to 1.30 P.M.

The Board met at 1.30 P.M. and completed the work of auditing claims.

T B Koolbeck appeared before the board, and requested that the poll taxes charged against him for the years 1909 & 1911 be canceled? He produced a certificate showing that he is an honorably discharged fireman of the Harlan Fire Department, and therefore he is not subject to poll tax.

The consent road petition of W E Cooper, Trustee for a new highway beginning at the North East corner of the North-West Quarter of the North-West Quarter in section 24 Twp 79, Range 39, and running thence East 80 rods was on motion granted.

The board on motion canceled the taxes of May Hack on lot 4, block 1, Tennant Iowa, for the years 1907, 1908, 1909 1910 1911 & 1912 on account of the owner's inability to contribute to the public revenue during that time.

On Motion the Board adjourned subject to call of the County Auditor.
