

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, January 27, 1915

The Board of Supervisors met today with members Pryor and Brodersen and County Auditor Schell present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board then approved the following bonds:

M. H. Woods, J. P.	\$500.00
H. D. Copeland Janitor	500.00
Fred F. Jackson, J. P.	500.00
C. S. Christiansen, J. P.	500.00
Will Kington, Twp. Clerk	3000.00

The Board then approved the Annual Report of C. J. Plagman, Justice of the Peace.

The received and accepted the resignation of M. C. Kuhl, Assessor of Westphalia Township.

The Board granted a refund ^{of \$6.00} to Hester A. Linn on account of Soldiers Exemption.

On motion the Board allowed P. F. Oldfield \$5.00 for shaving paper at Kirkman during the year 1915.

The Board of Supervisors reconsidered their action concerning the compensation of the census enumerators and same was fixed at follows: Population cards were raised from 3¢ to 5¢ each; Town cards from 5¢ to 7½¢ each; Farm cards from 10¢ to 15¢.

The Board on motion made the following pauper allowances: Rachel Miller \$8.00 per month; Newt Nelson \$10.00 per month; John Zimmer and parents \$20.00 per month; A. E. Potter and wife \$8.00 per month; Ida Jorgensen, a tubercular patient \$15.00 per month; J. A. Hansen and family \$20.00 per month; Vina Knudsen for house rent \$7.00 per month; Maria Larsen \$6.00 per month. The County Auditor was instructed to issue warrant each month for each of the above allowances during the year 1915.

The Board on motion adjourned to 1:00 o'clock P. M.


The Board met at 1:00 o'clock P. M. as per adjournment.

The Board instructed the County Auditor to pay B. B. McPheeters the sum of \$3.45 for disinfectants and to Dr. C. F. Vanatta the sum of \$7.00 for disinfecting the premises of R. L. Edwards in Monroe Township.

The Board then began the auditing of claims.

The Board in due time completed the auditing and allowing of claims. (For list of claims audited and allowed see Claim Register No. 8.)
