

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, March 9, 1915

The Board of Supervisors met today with members Pryor and Brodersen and County Auditor Schell present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

At the request of several citizens of Irwin, the monthly allowance to A. E. Potter was raised from \$8.00 to \$15.00 per month.

The Board then approved the bond of E. A. Moore, coroner, in the sum of \$1000.00.

The Board began the auditing and allowing of claims.

On motion Board adjourned to 1:00 o'clock P. M.

Board met at 1:00 o'clock P. M. and in due time completed the auditing of claims. (For list of claims audited and allowed see Claim Register No. 8.)

The Board then passed the following Resolution of Necessity:

RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY.

Date, March 9, 1915

Resolution No. 7

Be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, that it is deemed advisable and necessary to construct the following bridges and culverts.

Bet. 16 and 21, Center Twp., near SW cor. 16, concrete; width of roadway 46ft; depth of fill 6 ft; length of span 6'x4'; drainage area 185 ac., est. of cost. \$825.00.
Bet. 6 & 7 Cass Twp, 120 rds. E of SW cor. 6; concrete; width of roadway 24ft; depth of fill 6 in.; length of span 8'x6'; drainage area 430 ac.; est. of cost. \$750.00.
Bet. 12 & 13, Cass, 120 rds. E of SW cor. 12; concrete; width of roadway 24ft; depth of fill 6 in; length of span 8'x6'; drainage area 460 ac; est. of cost \$750.00.
Bet. 15 & 22 Cass Twp., 120 rds $\frac{1}{2}$ W of SE cor sec. 15; concrete; width of roadway 50ft; depth of fill 8ft; length of span 4'x3'; drainage area 60 ac; est of cost. \$540.00.
Center of S side 31 Jefferson Twp; wood with steel stringers; width of roadway 16ft; length of span 32ft; drainage area 630 ac; est. of cost. \$465.00.
Bet. 11 & 12 Greeley Twp. $\frac{1}{4}$ mi. S of school; wood; width of roadway ~~16~~ 16ft; length of span 40 ft; est. of cost \$323.43.
In 33 Grove Twp. E of Buckleys; wood; width of roadway 16ft; length of span 46ft; est. of cost \$365.58.
Bet 31 Center & 3 Fairview; wood with steel stringers; width of roadway 16ft; length of span 72ft; est. of cost \$985.00.

Be it further resolved that the Board of Supervisors will meet at 9 o'clock A. M. on the 26th day of March, 1915, at the office of the Board of Supervisors in the Shelby County Court House at Harlan, Iowa, for the purpose of considering objections to said proposed resolution, and that notice of said proposed resolution and of the passage of this resolution be published as provided by law.

That the Board of Supervisors will meet at 9 o'clock A. M. on the 26th day of March, 1915 at the Court House in Harlan, Iowa, when it will hear protests, if any, against the construction of said bridges and culverts.

I, E. A. Schell, County Auditor, hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution of Necessity was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, on the 9th day of March, 1915.
