

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, March 26, 1915

The Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, met today with members Miller, Brodersen, Arthur Pryor, chairman, and County Auditor Schell present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Resolution of Necessity which was adopted March 9, 1915, was passed.

The Board then received and examined the report of the State Examiners of the various County Officers and said report was placed on file.

The Application of the C. G. W. R. R. Co. for a change in the railroad bridge D-179 southwest of Harlan in Sec. 24, Lincoln Township was considered. The Board consented that the railroad company be permitted to move their pile bents 2'6" East, on condition that the road under said bridge be put in satisfactory condition.

The Board granted the recommendation of W. W. Wyland, assessor of the City of Harlan, to reduce the assessed valuation of Lot 7 in Block 14, Harlan, from \$800.00 to \$400.00 and the County Auditor was directed to make proper correction on tax lists.

The Board then began the auditing of claims.

On motion the Board adjourned to 1:00 o'clock P. M.

Board met at 1:00 o'clock P. M. as per adjournment and resumed the auditing of claims. The auditing of claims was completed. (For list of claims audited and allowed see Claim Register No. 8.)

At 2 o'clock P. M. the bids for culverts, concrete box culverts and new bridges were opened and examined. Thirteen bids were on file and the Lana Construction Company being the low bidder was awarded the contract at the following prices:-
