

## Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, April 5, 1915

The Board of Supervisors met today with all members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The County Auditor was directed to notify the publishers of the official papers, that hereafter all board proceedings shall be set in brevier type, this order being made for the purpose of securing uniformity in such claims; and it was also ordered that a copy of the proceedings as published shall be attached to each claim before same will be allowed.

The Board of Supervisors approved the contract and bond with the Green Bay Lumber Company, of Harlan, Iowa; said company to furnish lumber in car load lots at \$28.50 per M. and in smaller quantities at \$31.00 per M.

The Board appointed the following Soldiers Relief Commissioners for Shelby County:

L. H. Pickard	for three years from April 1, 1915
F. S. Kays	for two years from April 1, 1915
Geo. Ickes	for one year from April 1, 1915

Each to file a bond in the sum of \$500.00.

Pursuant to the recommendation of the State Examiners, the Sheriff was requested to file a complete report for the first quarter, 1915, which report the Sheriff filed, showing a balance due him for said quarter the sum of \$284.20 which amount the County Auditor was directed to pay. The Auditor was directed to pay the Sheriff's salary at the end of each month.

The Board then approved the first quarterly report of the County Auditor, to-wit:

"I herewith submit to you for your approval my first quarterly report for the year 1915. Total fees collected for quarter \$67.25." Treasurers receipt for \$67.25 hereto attached." Respectfully submitted. E. A. Schell, Co. Auditor.

The Board approved the Sheriff's first quarterly report, to-wit:

The Board approved the bond of L. H. Pickard as Soldiers Relief Commissioner in the sum of \$500.00.

The Board approved the bonds of the Dana Construction Co. on culvert and bridge contract.

The Board then adjourned to 1:30 P. M.

Board met at 1:30 P. M. and took up the auditing of claims. In due time the work of auditing of claims was completed and the Board adjourned to April 28, 1915 at 10 A. M. (For list of Claims audited and allowed see Claim Register No. 8.)
