

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, August 13, 1915

The Board of Supervisors met today as per adjournment with all members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

This being the day set for the opening of bids on the hill cutting work on the Pickard hill and the Schwab hill, same were opened and examined. There were five bids filed of which Fred A. Stevens was low bidder at a price of .22 $\frac{1}{4}$ per yard on the Schwab hill and a price of .18 $\frac{1}{4}$ per yard on the Pickard hill.

On motion the contract was awarded to Fred A. Stevens at his bid. His bond was fixed at \$750.00. Work to commence within fourteen days and same to be completed on or before November 1, 1915, with a penalty of \$5.00 per day for each day after November 1, 1915 if not completed, and a bonus of \$5.00 per day for each day the work is completed before November 1, 1915. Contract was made and entered into with Fred A. Stevens for this work.

The Board then began the auditing and allowing of claims.

On motion the Board adjourned to 1:30 o'clock P. M.

The Board met at 1:30 o'clock P. M. and continued the auditing of claims. In due time the work of auditing and allowing claims was completed and the Board of Supervisors adjourned sine die. (For list of claims added and allowed see Claim Register No. 7)
