

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, November 8, 1915

The Board of Supervisors met today with members Hans Brodersen, Chairman, Geo. E. Miller and M. H. Johnson and County Auditor E. A. Schell, present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board accepted the resignation of L. J. Best, Constable in Shelby Township.

The Board approved the lease with Rudolph Handke for land for road in Section 18, Grove Township and also lease with Laura Keairnes for land for road in Section 18, Grove Township.

The Board approved the School Fund Loan to Hattie Kirby in the sum of \$200.00 for a term of five years.

The Board then took up the auditing of claims.

The Board on motion adjourned to 8:30 o'clock A. M. November 9, 1915.

The Board met at 8:30 o'clock A. M. November 9, 1915 as per adjournment.

The Board approved the third quarterly report of H. F. Wunder, County Recorder. Report follows:-
