Harlan, Iowa, January 15, 1918

The Board of Supervisors met today with members N. H. Johnson, Hans Brodersen and Geo. E. Miller and County Auditor E. A. Schell present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board approved the Road Report of Lincoln Township.

The Board approved the following Justice of the Peace reports: J. D. Dunlavy, H. B. Sooy and Peter Steenhusen.

The Board approved the applications for extension of School Fund Loans of Geo. D. and W. B. Pierce and Wm. Hayes.

The Bridge reports were placed on file and ordered published.

The Board on motion adjourned to 1:30 o'clock P. M.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

At 10:00 o'clock A. M. bids were opened for corrugated culverts, concrete culverts, and bridge lumber. There were bids on file from the following bidders:
