

## Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

November 11th, 1918.

THE Board of Supervisors met today in regular session with members N. H. Johnson, Hans Broderson and Geo. E. Miller present, also Glen P. Howard, Auditor.

The minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

At twelve o'clock noon the Board commenced the official canvas of the vote cast at the General Election held on November 5th, 1918,

The Board on motion adjourned to Nine o'clock A. M. on November 12th, 1918.

The Board of Supervisors met today at Nine O'clock A. M. with member Geo. E. Miller and Hans Broderson, Supervisors and Glen P. Howard, Auditor, present.

The Board of Supervisors again resumed the canvas of the vote.

The Board on motion adjourned to One o'clock P. M.

The Board met at One o'clock as per adjournment.

The Board again took up the canvas of the vote and in due time completed same.

For the office of Railroad Commissioner there were 6107 votes cast of which Dwight N. Lewis received 1573; Charles Webster 1688; George W. Koontz 1488; Joseph F. Beh 1329; William Rodgers 16; J. C. Knowlton 13.

For the office of Representative in Congress Ninth District there were 1957 votes cast of which William R. Green received 1957.

For the office of Superintendent of Public Instruction there were 3042 votes cast of which P. E. McClenahan received 1508; G. W. Walters 1518; M. F. Wiltse 14; Eleanor Chafin Stockman 2.

For the office of State Senator Eighteenth District there were 2994 of which Julius Nelson received 1728; John C. Vorhees 1266.

For the office of Supervisor of East District there were 2675 votes cast of which Hans Broderson received 1450; Ole E. Johnson 1225.
