

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, March 4, 1919

The Board of Supervisors met today with members Hans Brodersen and Geo. E. Miller and County Auditor Glen P. Howard present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board ordered that the taxes of Polly Weeks, Blanche Bare and Mrs. Frank Book be paid from the Poor Fund. *pd. Poor MT #487*

The Board ordered that the taxes of Ulrich Summers on certain property in the City of Harlan be remitted for the year 1915 for the reason that he was not given the exemption allowed to veterans of the Civil War.

The County Auditor was authorized to issue transfer orders transferring ^{150.00} ~~200.00~~ from the Township Road Fund of Greeley Township to the County Road Fund and transferring ^{300.00} ~~150.00~~ from the Township Road Fund of Union Township to the County Road Fund on account of money advanced by Shelby County for the filling of culverts on the Township Road System.

The County Auditor was authorized to cancel the tax of Stephen Andersen in Fairview Township for the year 1917, as he was assessed in Clay Township for the same year and paid tax in Clay Township.

The Board approved the following bonds: H. E. Lee, janitor; J. E. Wehr, constable Cass Township; L. E. Heflin, Clerk Center Township; Walter A. Kolb, Clerk Clay Township; John Rosenthal, assessor Portsmouth Town.

The Board on motion adjourned to 1:30 o'clock P. M.

The Board met at 1:30 P. M. as per adjournment.

The Board took up the work of auditing claims and in due time completed same.
