

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, April 7, 1919

The Board of Supervisors met today with members Hans Brodersen and Geo. E. Miller and County Auditor Glen P. Howard present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

On account of the Convention of School Presidents which was called for this date the Board on motion adjourned to April 8, 1919.

Harlan, Iowa, April 8, 1919

The Board of Supervisors met today with members Hans Brodersen, Geo. E. Miller and N. H. Johnson and County Auditor Glen P. Howard present.

The minutes of the meeting of April 7, were read and approved.

The County Auditor was instructed to draw warrant upon the Poor Fund of Shelby County in favor of Ora Blanche Bare, to reimburse her for taxes paid by her which taxes should have been remitted. *PA # 494 MT # 539*

The Board approved the bond of M. H. Woods, Justice of the Peace, in Douglas Township.

The Board approved the bond of the Wickham Bridge & Pipe Co., of Council Bluffs, Iowa, for the furnishing of lumber to Shelby County in the sum of \$3000.00.

The Board approved the 1st quarterly report of the County Auditor which report shows that the Auditor received as fees for transferring deeds, etc. the sum of \$74.50, which amount was paid into the County Treasurer, and his receipt for same attached.

The Board approved the 1st quarterly report of C. W. McNaughton Sheriff.

It was resolved by the Board of Supervisors that the compensation for dragging County Roads for the year 1919 be fixed at .90¢ per mile.

The Board on motion adjourned to 1:30 o'clock P. M.

The Board met at 1:30 o'clock P. M. as per adjournment.

The Board took up the work of auditing and allowing claims and devoted the afternoon to this work, adjourning on motion to April 9, 1919.

The Board met on April 9, 1919 and again took up the work of auditing and allowing claims which work was in due time completed. (For list of claims audited and allowed see Claim Register No. 9.)

In order to have a regular date of meetings of the Board of Supervisors each month it was resolved by the Board that the first Tuesday in each month be fixed as a day for meetings, except when this date interferes with dates already fixed.

It was resolved by the Board that persons having domestic animals killed or injured by dogs or wolves should notify the member of the Board of Supervisors in his district as soon as the killed or injured animals are found.

It was agreed by the Board that May 6, 1919 be fixed as the day for receiving bids on corrugated culvert pipe and the County Auditor was directed to advertise for bids on same.

The Board on motion adjourned to May 6, 1919 at 9:00 o'clock A. M.
