

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, July 8, 1919

The Board of Supervisors met today with members Hans Brodersen, N. H. Johnson and Geo. E. Miller and County Auditor Glen P. Howard present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

This being the day set for hearing on the Karstens Road Matter in Fairview Township and there having been objections and claims for damages filed this matter was continued to the next meeting of the Board on Aug. 4, 1919, and the County Auditor was directed to appoint appraisers to appraise the damages and make report at once.

The Board on motion adjourned to take up matters in Drainage District No. 9, and in proposed Drainage District No. 11, to meet again at 1:30 o'clock P. M.

The Board met at 1:30 o'clock P. M. and immediately drove to Panama to meet L. M. Martin, District Highway Engineer, and J. H. Ames, Highway Bridge Engineer, and to inspect some bridges in the West District, from which trip they returned at 4:00 o'clock.

This being the day set for hearing on the Caldwell road matter in Sec. 12, Lincoln Township, the Board took up this matter. The appraisers having filed report fixing the damages at \$200.00, and there being objections and a claim for damages filed by Mr. Caldwell in the sum of \$500.00, the Board after consideration, overruled the objections and fixed the amount of damages as set by the Appraisers and the County Auditor was authorized to issue warrant drawn on the Road fund in favor of C. E. Caldwell in the sum of \$200.00. The Board ordered that the strip of road ~~#####~~ described in the County Engineer's recommendation be made a part of the township road between Sections 1 and 12, Lincoln Township, and the County Auditor was ordered to enter same on the road record and plat. *pt. 111 397*

The Board on motion adjourned to July 9, 1919.


The Board of Supervisors met today with members Hans Brodersen and N. H. Johnson and County Auditor Glen P. Howard present.
