

Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, August 4, 1919

The Board of Supervisors met today with members Hans Brodersen, Geo. E. Miller and N. H. Johnson, and Deputy County Auditor W. R. Koolbeck present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board postponed action on the Karstens Road Matter relative to the opening of a road in Fairview Township, until the next meeting.

The Board took up the auditing of claims and continued this work during the morning session.

The Board on motion adjourned to 1:30 o'clock P. M.

The Board met at 1:30 o'clock P. M. as per adjournment, and again took up the auditing and allowing of claims which work was in due time completed. (For list of claims audited and allowed see Claim Register No. 9.)

The Board of Supervisors upon motion passed the following resolution in the matter of the issuance of Funding Bonds:

Whereas, there has been presented to this, the Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, by the WHITE-PHILLIPS COMPANY, Davenport, Iowa, a written proposition to carry at face value the warrants of said county issued against the Bridge Fund and such other Funds as may be overdrawn, which warrants are to be funded into Funding Bonds at the January 1920 session of the Board of Supervisors of said County, and the said written proposition is in all respects satisfactory to all parties concerned, now therefore, Be it resolved, by the Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, that the written proposition of the WHITE-PHILLIPS COMPANY, Davenport, Iowa, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, the County Auditor, and the County Treasurer, are hereby authorized to contract.

A copy of above proposition is on file in the office of the County Auditor.

The Farm Bureau Association of Shelby County, Iowa, having made application for aid from Shelby County, Iowa, and having made sufficient showing that they had a membership of Two Hundred (200) farmers, and that their members have subscribed the sum of One Thousand Dollars, it is incumbent upon the Board of Supervisors of Shelby County, Iowa, that they appropriate to the said Farm Bureau Association, a sum double the amount of the subscription, The said Board of Supervisors hereby appropriate the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00), the same to be paid to the Treasurer of the Farm Bureau Association of Shelby County, by warrant drawn upon the General County Fund of Shelby County, Iowa, and the County Auditor is hereby authorized to issue said warrant.

The Board of Supervisors authorized the County Auditor to destroy all duplicate tax receipts, saloon consent petitions and remonstrances, liquor requests, poll tax receipts and hunters license applications which have been on file in the offices of the County Treasurer or County Auditor for more than five years.

There being no further business at this time the Board on motion adjourned to September 8, 1919.
