

# Supervisors' Minute Book, No. 7, Shelby County, Iowa.

Session, 191

Harlan, Iowa, September 8, 1919

The Board of Supervisors met today in regular session with members Hans Brodersen, Geo. E. Miller and N. H. Johnson and County Auditor Glen P. Howard present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board postponed action upon the Karstens road matter until the next meeting.

The Board on motion adjourned to 1:30 o'clock P. M.

The Board met at 1:30 o'clock P. M.

The Board approved the quarterly report of W. B. Woods, County Recorder, and found that he had received for transferring instruments the sum of \$248.30, which amount had been turned over to the County Treasurer and his receipt was attached to said report.

The Board approved the refund of tax on a valuation of \$200.00 to Nels H. Christensen, on certain lot in Harlan, Iowa, on account of an erroneous assessment.

The Board of Supervisors met today with members Hans Brodersen, Geo. E. Miller and N. H. Johnson and County Auditor Glen P. Howard present.

The Board then proceeded to make the tax levies for the year 1919 as follows:

A poll tax of 50¢ was levied against every male resident of Shelby County of the age of twenty-one years or over.

A tax of \$1000 was ordered assessed against each male or spayed female dog; a tax of \$3.00 was ordered assessed against each female dog.
