We, the undersigned Members of the Board of Supervisors and ex-officio County Board of Canvassers for this County, do hereby certify the following to be a true and correct abstract of the votes cast in this County at the 2006 General Election held on the 7th day of November, 2006, as shown by the tally lists returned from the several election precincts.

For the public measure

SILO ELECTION, EXPIRING 12-31-2018

Shall the County of Shelby, State of Iowa, be authorized to impose a One Percent School Infrastructure Local Option Sales Tax for school infrastructure projects for ten years, beginning on January 1, 2009 and ending on December 31, 2018?

For the question, there were: Two thousand four hundred seventy-seven (2477) votes

Against the question, there were: One thousand two hundred thirty-two (1232) votes

TOTAL Three thousand seven hundred nine (3709) votes

We therefore declare the public measure "Shall the County of Shelby, State of Iowa, be authorized to impose a One Percent School Infrastructure Local Option Sales Tax for school infrastructure projects for ten years, beginning on January 1, 2009 and ending on December 31, 2018?" to be adopted.
